



Informational Meeting with Our District Superintendent

We are now entering the final stages of the discernment process regarding whether our church remains connected with the United Methodist denomination or if we choose to depart based on matters related to human sexuality and the impact these issues may have on the church.

This past week we have had two Listening Sessions. Members of the congregation were given the opportunity to hear from our Lay Leadership Group about the work they have done over the past two years. Their work has focused on gathering information and reporting their findings and recommendations to the Church Council. To reiterate, the Lay Leadership is not making the decision for the church. It will provide a recommendation to either stay connected as United Methodist or to hold a Church Conference for the purpose of voting. Their recommendation will come to the Church Council based on many hours of meeting, discussing, listening to you, and praying for discernment. I hope you will join with me in expressing appreciation to the members of this group for the work they have done on behalf of our church.

There was a beautiful spirit in both of the Listening Sessions. It was apparent that people are passionate about their positions on these matters that are before us, but there was an overriding sense that people were ready to listen and to try to understand the opinions of others. The sessions provided evidence yet again of how God is at work in our church and in the hearts of our people as we move through the discernment process together.

On Wednesday, June 26, 6:00pm, our District Superintendent, Rev. Dr. Scott Hagan, will join us to facilitate an informal informational meeting. He will discuss the advantages of remaining in the United Methodist Church, the steps of the departure process should we choose to depart, and the implications that departure would have on our church. He will also answer the questions that have been submitted online or in writing. The deadline for submitting your questions is Sunday, June 23. This will give us the time to take questions that are similar and combine them into a single question to be addressed. There will also be an opportunity during the meeting to provide additional questions in writing.

Please continue to pray for God's direction in your lives as well as the life of the church. It remains my prayer that no matter the outcome that we will find a way to still be the church together. I invite you to join me in making Romans 15:5-6 your prayer: "Now may the God of endurance and comfort give us unity with one another in accordance with Christ Jesus, so that together we may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ."

If the Church Council votes to remain connected to the United Methodist Church, this meeting will not be necessary. If the Church Council votes to hold a Church Conference for the purpose of voting on departure, only members of St. Simons UMC who are present at the Church Conference will have a vote. A two-thirds vote to depart is required for approval. Proxy voting is not allowed by The Book of Discipline.


- First time guests please fill out the yellow, "Welcome Card" located in your pew. Please drop in the offering plate or bring to the Welcome Desk to receive a gift!
