





The man had lost his job. He was angry and hurt. He tried to tough it out because after all, that's what guys do. But things got worse. Tensions increased in his family. His circle of friends seemed to look at him differently. His unemployment created some awkward situations. He wasn't sure about his next steps. He realized he could use help.

He had heard about the Stephen Ministry program in his church. He wondered if it was something that might be helpful. But he hesitated to reach out. He thought of how embarrassing it would be for him to admit that he had a problem. Still, the ministry promoted itself as being there to help when people were experiencing difficult days. He was definitely a candidate; he knew he could benefit from someone to talk to. He contacted the Stephen Ministry Leader in the church and was assigned a Stephen Minister. Eventually, with the help of his Stephen Minister, he was able to work through this time of transition with less stress and more confidence.

Stephen Ministry and those who serve in this ministry are an incredible asset to our church. Their role complements our pastoral care ministry in that they are always available to be with someone in his or her time of need. The Stephen Minister becomes a non-judgmental, supportive companion on a person's journey. Their role is not to fix the person's problems, but to help guide them towards discovering the answers they need for themselves. Stephen Ministers are not trained counselors – they are trained to be active listeners and compassionate care givers while maintaining a strict level of confidentiality.

This Sunday we celebrate the commissioning of two new Stephen Ministers, Sherry Pickett, and Edie Payne. They will be commissioned during the 11:00 worship service. To arrive at this point in time they each have completed 50 hours of detailed training. Please pray for them and offer them your support as they begin their caregiving journeys.


