

## Prayer is the Best Thing You Can Do

How is your prayer life? I'm not talking about a quick blessing over a meal, I'm talking about spending time with God on a consistent basis.

In the busy routines of our lives, it is sometimes difficult to set aside time to talk with God. If that's the case, maybe we need to consider more closely the stewardship of our time. No time to communicate with God and others is one of the quickest paths to a breakdown in a relationship. For our relationship with God to grow deeper and stronger it is essential that we dedicate time each day to prayer.

There was a man whose friend was going through an extremely difficult season in his life. The man said to his hurting friend: "The least I can do is pray for you." His friend smiled and responded, "No, that's the best thing you can do."

Prayer is the best thing you can do! Sometimes we discount the importance of daily prayers. As a result, our relationship with God grows stale; we feel like God is distant and that he does not care. When we reclaim the power of prayer and give it the priority it deserves, we will find that it not only strengthens us but also our connections with others.

Paul in his letter to the Philippians writes, "Do not worry about anything, but in everything with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7)

This Sunday we will consider one of the more memorable, even controversial, thanksgiving prayers in the Bible - the prayer of Hannah, who was the mother of Samuel. We will discover how Hannah's prayer serves to remind us that prayer is the best thing you can do today and every day.
