Just Can't Be Satisfied

It was the Summer of 1965, and I had just turned 12 years old. As was our daily custom, my friends and I got on our bikes and rode to the Statesboro Recreation Center where we would just hang around every day. They always played the popular songs of the day through speakers set up around the pavilion and the pool, and we would listen to the new songs as we tried to look cool and impress girls. I will always remember the blaring sound of the fuzz guitar opening the sound of the Rolling Stones number one hit "Satisfaction." This song, with that guitar hook and the wailing voice of Mick Jagger, became the anthem of teenage angst for the summer, expressing so well the confusing times of beginning our teen years. The feeling that we felt was one of not being satisfied with our young lives.

That feeling of not being satisfied with life, is one that is a part of being human. No matter what life brings you would be hard pressed to find anyone who is satisfied with it. There always seems to be something that we don't like or that we wish was different. In our Bible reading for February 6 in Exodus 16, we find the Israelite people about 3 months out of captivity, wishing they were slaves again! They said to Moses, we had plenty to eat as slaves back in Egypt, but now you've brought us out in the middle of nowhere to starve. God hears their whining and sends manna from heaven and has it rain quail providing both bread and meat. He had already given them water so they had everything they needed, but still it wasn't enough to satisfy them. Their problem was that they did not trust God.

That is often our problem as well. We put our trust in money, or possessions, or people or governments, and it's never enough. We just can't be satisfied. Paul found that when he put his total trust in God through Christ, he was fulfilled. He wrote these words from a prison cell: "I have learned, in whatever state I am, to be content." How could he write that? It was because he had learned the secret of satisfaction in life. He was now trusting God through Christ and that was all the satisfaction he needed. Putting God first above all else enabled him to overcome any circumstance of living! As he put it, "I can do all things through Him who strengthens me!" May God help us to truly trust in Him through His Son Jesus so that whatever life brings we will be satisfied!


